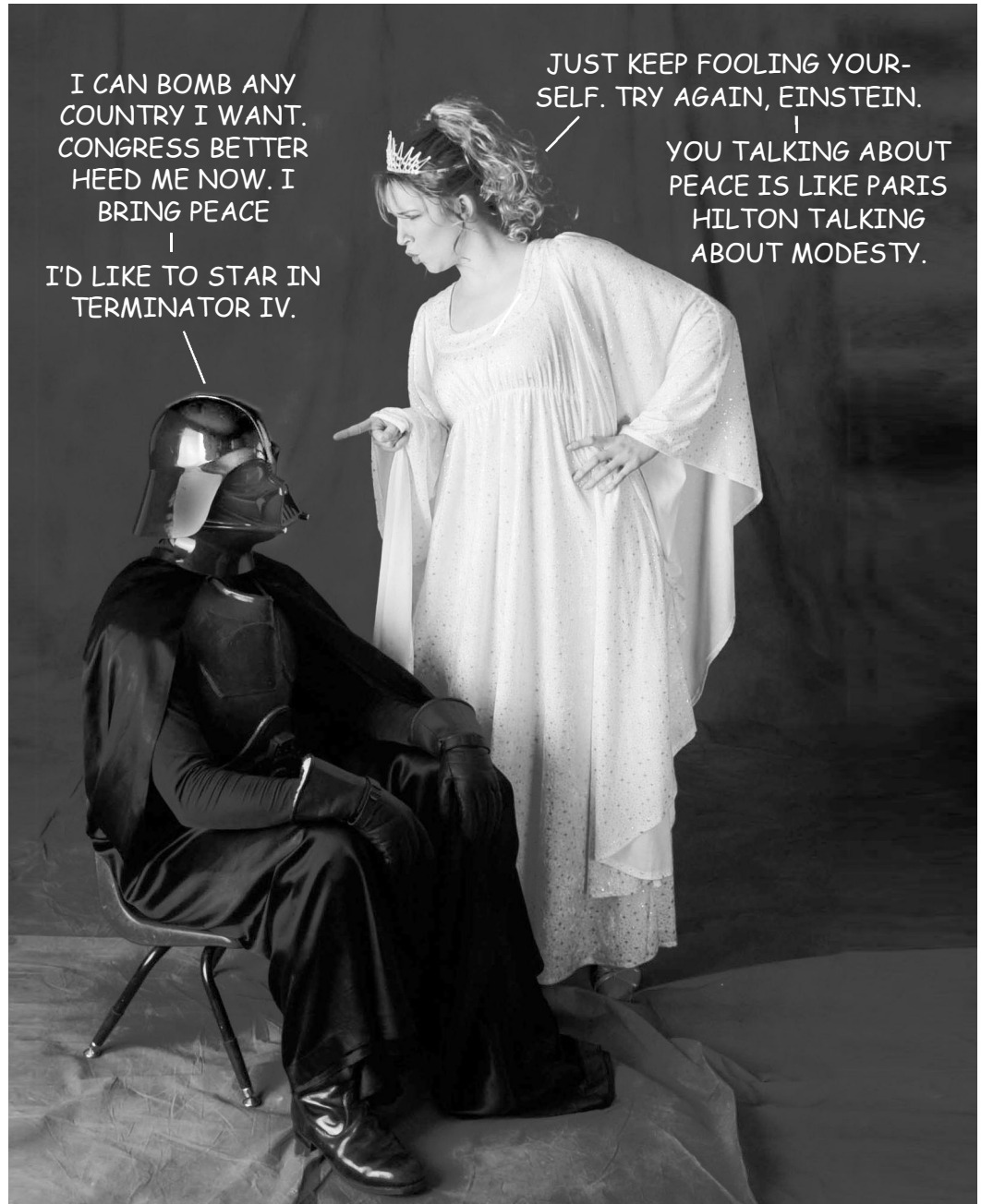


Danger — getting too big!
